Title: Keystone Art & Culture Center

Deadline: Open deadline – submissions reviewed quarterly

Type: Regional and International Call for Submissions

Category: Emphasis on Sculpture, accepting Multiple Media including 2D

Fees: No Entry Fee, Sales Subject to 30% commission (70% to artists)

Description

Keystone Art & Culture Center (KACC) is a non-profit arts educational center focusing on the promotion and advancement of Sculpture and Bronze casting. The Center houses an 1,800 sq. ft. gallery space adjacent to a 3000sq. ft. art foundry facilities. The exhibit space is 10 feet high with a 36 foot by 50 foot floor space. White wall and exposed brick wall areas. Some pedestals for sculpture available.

We are planning our 2009-2010 calendar of shows and are looking for artist(s) to exhibit their work. Shows run on a 1 to 3 month basis with an opening event typically on the Fourth Friday and occasionally also on First Friday of each month. KACC may also hold special events in addition to the first Friday openings. Exhibits may also be featured in City wide arts events.

Eligibility

Open to all artists with additional consideration on those in Pennsylvania, and the Mid-Atlantic States working in all media. All forms of painting, drawing, sculpture, photography, graphics, digital and installation art are eligible. Eligible artists are not necessarily guaranteed an exhibition date - Keystone Art & Culture reserves the right to decline any submission upon review.

Accepted artists are responsible for shipping to and from the gallery as scheduled for the exhibit. Entrants must be 18 years of age or older to qualify. Accepted artist(s) will receive additional information upon scheduling.

Acceptable Submission Format

Originals are not accepted for submission review. Submission materials must be digital images at 300Dpi (1800x1800) in JPG or Tiff formats provided on CD or DVD. Make sure that the quality of your visuals is as close to the original as possible. Images should clearly represent the type of work proposed for exhibition in the gallery. Keep files to a maximum of 10MB please. Be sure to include a reference sheet with an image representing each work on the CD/DVD. Next to each image include file name, artists name, dimensions of work, media, date completed, and price information. If multiple pages, please include the artist name on each page. Remember to write the file name on the reference sheet next to the corresponding image.

Application Fee

There is no entry fee

Return of Materials

A Self-Addressed-Stamped-Envelope (SASE) must be included for the return of any materials. Materials submitted without the above SASE will not be returned – exceptions. Ensure that your materials fit easily inside your return envelope and you have sufficient postage. (We are not responsible for return of

materials without SASE or due to insufficient postage.) You may wish to include mailing insurance for the return of your materials. You must identify which materials are to be returned and provide shipping and handling sufficient for their return.

Notification

Following receipt and review of your application, artist(s) who are selected for exhibition will be notified of acceptance on a quarterly basis. Applications will be reviewed quarterly. Notification will be made by email or phone. Accepted entrants must sign release form/artists agreement and agree with the following conditions:

- Artists will be responsible for transport of work to and from the gallery as scheduled. The artist is responsible for any insurance of his/her work during transit to and from the gallery, this includes shipping and/or mailing. (While utmost care is given to all artwork, and excellent security and insurance are in place during exhibition, KACC does not assume any liability for damage or loss during shipping.)
- Artists will be responsible for presenting his/her art in a professional manner. All 2D work should be framed or gallery wrapped and ready to hang, (with no visible staples on stretched canvas). All 2d work must be wired and show ready upon receipt. Our staff will plan and organize the hanging. Artists are encouraged to assist in hanging if available. KACC has a number of pedestals for display of sculpture. Arrangements can be made to accommodate the artist's pedestals. We reserve the rights to reject works that are poorly presented or otherwise deemed inappropriate by KACC.

Commission

There is a 30% commission on any sales made during the exhibition or as a result of the exhibition including, sales generated by email, publication, and promotion of the artists work provided by KACC. Pennsylvania Sales Tax applies to all sales.

- Images on CD or DVD (**DO NOT** send originals) reference sheet must be provided.
- Proposal Form (Download)
- SASE for return of items (must ID what items are for return)
